Report Exact Foundation 2023

In 2023, the Exact Foundation further built on its reshaped mission: "The Exact Foundation believes in equal chances and opportunities for all. By supporting unique learning initiatives, we help people who need it to progress."

The Exact Foundation continued its support to TechMeUp and Codam in 2023. Additionally, the Exact Foundation kept searching for additional projects. As a result, a commitment was made to support JINC and, as of early 2024, an agreement was made with Belgium based organization ArmenTeKort vzw to start supporting the project 'ElkKindTelt' (Every Child Counts). The Exact Foundation is looking into additional projects to support in 2024 as well.

Board change

In August 2023, Louise Meijer stepped down as board member of the Exact Foundation. Paul Ramakers continued as the Exact Foundation's chairman, with Daisy Geelen and Karin Opsteegh completing the board. Louise Meijer has not been replaced and the Exact Foundation is currently moving forward with a board of 3 members.

Supported projects

TechMeUp (The Netherlands) – Helping new talents into the tech world.

TechMeUp grants scholarships to those who, for whatever reason, need help to retrain themselves and complete a tech curriculum. TechMeUp invests in providing opportunities and believes education should be accessible regardless of one's situation or circumstances. There's a thorough selection process and only the real ambitious and determined make it to the program.

Codam (The Netherlands) – Preparing for tomorrow's jobs in the tech world.

Codam prepares the new generation for the jobs of today and tomorrow by providing accessible software engineering education to a diverse group of people who do not have access to the regular educational curriculum. Codam supports students with their travel costs and sustenance, enabling them to follow a fulltime education and have a successful start in the tech industry. The monthly selection process is intense, making sure only the dedicated and motivated students enter the program.

Jinc Delft - Everyone grows with Jinc

Every child is talented, including the 600,000 children in the Netherlands growing up in an environment with fewer role models with which to identify. JINC strives for a society in which a child's background does not determine their future; a society in which every child gets a fair chance. In order to reach that goal, we help young people between the ages of 8 and 16 get off to a good start on the labour market. Through the JINC program, they get acquainted with various professions, find out what kind of work suits their talents, and learn how to apply for a job.

New project from 2024 onwards

ArmenTekort, project ElkKindTelt (Belgium) – Breaking through the poverty of generations and avoiding early school drop-outs. High school students are guided throughout their entire high school period by the ElkKindTelt team of volunteers, in collaboration with the schools. Through home visits and hands-on typically non-monetary support, the aim is to enhance the well-being and commitment of both child and parent(s), all with the goal to get a school-diploma, which will increase chances of escaping poverty.
